The Company recognises that successful health and safety management contributes to successful business performance and will allocate adequate finances and resources to meet these needs.

The Company will ensure a systematic approach to identifying hazards and risks from our activities, products and services and we will take action to continually improve our health and safety performance by implementing an Occupational Health and Safety Management System based on the requirements of OHSAS 45001 together with Section 2 of the Health and Safety at Work Act 1974.

We will define health and safety objectives, targets and improvement actions that are related to this policy and to our significant health and safety risks. We will regularly evaluate progress against these through our 'Management Review' process. Verification takes place every 6 months at the time of our Management Review Meeting

We are committed to providing relevant health and safety training and promoting health and safety awareness to employees and, where appropriate, to suppliers and to communicating our health and safety performance.

We will implement processes to prevent health and safety accidents, incidents, near misses and other nonconformities and to ensure that we are prepared to deal with potential health and safety emergencies.

All employees have duties under the Health and Safety at Work etc. Act 1974 and are informed of their personal responsibilities to take due care of the health and safety of themselves and to ensure that they do not endanger other persons by their acts or omissions. Employees are also informed that they must co-operate with the Company in order that it can comply with the legal requirements placed upon it and in the implementation of this policy. We are committed to continued consultation with the workforce to enable all viewpoints and recommendations to be discussed at regular intervals.

This policy will be regularly reviewed and updated to take account of organisational priorities and changes, health and safety legislation and best practice. To aid this process Project Pipeline Supply Ltd is guided by the FPB (Forum of Private Business) who provide advisory service and a yearly Health and Safety Guideline bible together with Citation who provide external competent advice.
